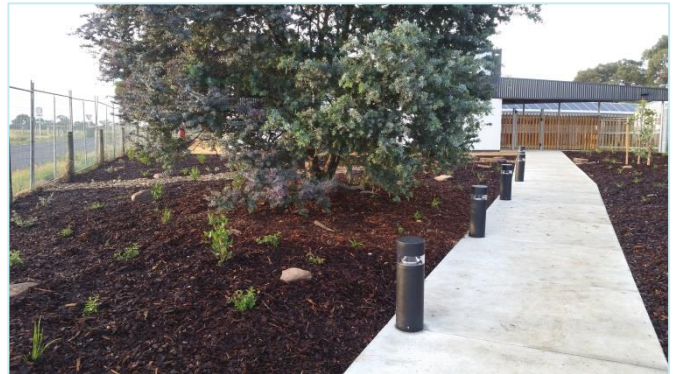
Increasing surveillance

- Recruitment for people to work in the centre

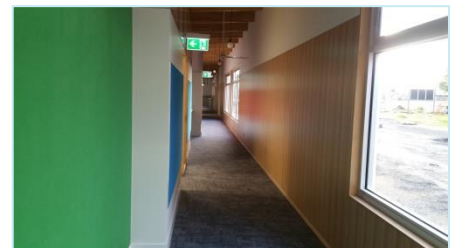
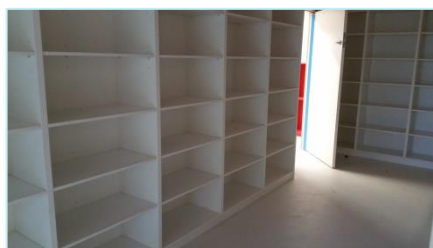
